1 SUCCULENT 1

CUT ALL 14 LEAVES FROM CARD STOCK

CUT SLIT IN NARROW POINT OF EACH LEAF



3

CROSS OVER TIPS TO FORM CUPS AND GLUE. OVERLAP THE THREE SAME SIZE LEAVES TOGETHER TO MAKE 6 SETS

GLUE TWO SETS OF CENTER TREE-LEAVES TOGETHER AND CURL WITH SCISSORS TO FORM A SMALL BALL

PUT A LARGE FLORAL PIN THROUGH CENTER OF LARGEST LEAF SET

GLUE LEAF SETS INSIDE OF EACH, LARGER TO SMALLEST. MAKE SURE TO ROTATE LEAVES FOR THE MOST NATURAL LOOK
